

INJURIES AND INJURY SEVERITY

Highest AIS score: (1-6)

Head AIS score:

- 1 = minor
- 2 = moderate
- 3 = serious
- 4 = severe
- 5 = critical
- 6 = unsurvivable

Body region with highest AIS score:

- Externa (skin)
- Head and Neck
- Face
- Thorax/chest
- Abdomen and pelvic contentes
- Extremities and pelvic girdle

Spine injuries:

- Cervical spine: No Yes Unknown
- Thoracic spine: No Yes Unknown
- Lumbar spine: No Yes Unknown

1. Minor: no treatment needed.
2. Moderate: requires only outpatient treatment.
3. Serious: requires non-ICU hospital admission.
4. Severe: requires ICU observation and/or basic treatment.
5. Critical: requires intubation, mechanical ventilation or vasopressors for blood pressure support.
6. Maximal: not survivable.

Notes:

- Spine is not considered separately in the original ISS classification, but included under the neck/chest and abdomen regions. For TBI however, we consider it important to record spine separately. Thus, if the AIS severity of the spine overrides these corresponding body regions, these regions should not be considered separately in the ISS calculation.
- If any body region AIS is assigned a '6', the ISS is automatically set to 75 (highest score).
