1. CDE Variable	DatTim = Date and Time
2. CDE Definition	Date and time variables provide accurate documentation of the date and time of events.
3. Recommended instrument for assessment	Calendar/clock
4. Description of measure	Date; Hours/minutes
5. Permissible values	Date: DD-MMM-YYYY 99-999-9999 if unknown Time: HH-MM 99-99 if unknown
6. Classification: Basic/Intermediate/Advanced	Identical
7. Procedure	Record information as accurately as possible.
8. Comments/Special instructions: Month is recorded in letters in order to prevent confusion between US and European approaches to coding. Hours/minutes to be recorded on a 24 hours clock.
